

COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE O-2018-013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF NEWPORT, KENTUCKY PURSUANT TO SECTION 71.60 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AMENDING THE ONE-WAY STREET SCHEDULE IN CHAPTER 73, CHANGING THE RESTRICTION ON THE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC ON FOURTH STREET AND FIFTH STREET NEAR VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE

WHEREAS, following the construction of traffic circles by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet joining KY Route 8 and Route 9, to facilitate traffic entering and exiting arteries to the traffic circles leading to and from Fourth and Fifth Streets in Newport, and to improve ease of access and safety for those entering and leaving the City, changes to the direction of traffic are necessitated to redirect the flow on a long-term basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NEWPORT, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the One-Way Street Schedule in Chapter 73 concerning portions of Fourth and Fifth Streets shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>	<i>Direction</i>
Fifth Street	From <u>Central Avenue</u> [Veteran's Memorial Bridge] to Park Avenue	Easterly
Fourth Street	From Linden Avenue to <u>Central Avenue</u> [Veteran's Memorial Bridge]	Westerly

SECTION II

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, recorded, published and effective upon publication.

The portion of **Fourth Street** indicated above in **PURPLE**, from **Central Avenue to the traffic circle at Veterans Memorial Bridge**, traffic flow will change to accommodate two-way traffic entering and exiting the traffic circle constructed by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet at the junction of KY Route 8 and Route 9.

(Note that on Fourth Street from Linden Avenue to Central Avenue, traffic flow has been and will remain one-way in a westbound direction.)

For the portion of **Fifth Street** indicated above in **VIOLET**, from **the traffic circle at Veterans Memorial Bridge to Central Avenue**, traffic flow will change to accommodate two-way traffic entering and exiting the traffic circles constructed by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet at the junction of KY Route 8 and Route 9.

(Note that on Fifth Street from Central Avenue to Park Avenue, traffic flow has been and will remain one-way traffic in an eastbound direction.)
