A Summary of the Ordinances related to Vicious Dogs

- **Vicious Dogs must have a dog license from the City. The fee is \$10.**
(All dogs must have a license from the County – visit 1098 Monmouth for the County License.)
- **Show proof of vaccinations, proof of microchip, proof of spay/neuter, and proof of liability insurance coverage (minimum amount of \$100,000).**
- **No more than 1 vicious dog per household.**
- **Vicious dogs must be kenneled or, when being walked, must be muzzled and kept on a leash not more than six feet in length.**
- **The license tag must be worn by the dog at all times.**

By definition in the Ordinance, the following are considered Vicious Dogs:

1. Any dog which constitutes a physical threat to human beings or other animals by virtue of a known or displayed propensity to endanger by pursuing, wounding or attacking any other domestic animal or human being;
2. Any dog that has exhibited a tendency to do any act which might endanger the safety, health or well-being of any person or other animal without sufficient provocation for such act;
3. Any dog trained, owned or harbored for the purpose, primarily or in part, of animal fighting;
4. Any animal which has been trained to attack persons independently or upon oral command, excepting animals owned by public law enforcement agencies
5. American Staffordshire Terrier or Staffordshire Bull Terrier or American Pit Bull Terrier and any breed or mixed breed of dog having any part of the standards or characteristics thereof.
