

COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE NO. O-2023-004

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
NEWPORT, KENTUCKY AMENDING SECTION 32.064 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES CONCERNING COMPOSITION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION.**

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
NEWPORT, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION I

That Section 32.064 of the Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32.064 COMPOSITION.

The Commissioner shall consist of seven (7) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners, all of whom shall be residents of the City and who shall have demonstrated an interest in historic preservation. At least two (2) members shall be residents of the East Row Historic District; at least one (1) member shall be a resident of the York Street Local Historic District; and at least two (2) members shall meet the qualifications of a preservation-related professional as defined in Section 32.061 hereof. Any subsequent local districts that may be created shall also be required to have a representative member thereof. No more than two (2) members shall reside outside of the local designated historic district.

SECTION II

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, published and effective upon publication.
